

Bag Lites™ Instructions

(Part #CV4500-CV4501)

Parts included:

- (2) or (4) Bag Lites Assembly
- Electrical Wiring
- Installation time: 2.5 - 3 hours

Instructions:

1. Remove the Bag Lites™ and hardware from the package.
2. Remove the saddlebags.
3. Remove or lower the rear wheel.
4. Remove the seat.
5. Remove the tail light lens and unplug the wires for the turn signals.
6. Remove the rear turn signal light bar.
7. You may elect to install our new Eliminator Tail Lite Assembly (P/N CV-4800) or a chrome license plate holder (Drag Specialties P/N DS-270110) in place of the light bar (you just removed). Both items come with a special bracket to remove the OEM license plate holder and bracket.
8. Install the wires through the access hole in fender and open the plastic clips (inside the right side of fender) run the wires in the clips.
9. Plug in both wires where you unplugged the turn signals.
10. Run the wire between the frame and fender to the saddlebags.
11. Install the saddlebag and apply masking tape to the area where the Bag Lites™ are to be installed.
12. Place the Bag Lites™ on the bag and mark the hole. Make sure the holes are lined up parallel to the other saddlebag Bag Lites™.
13. Drill the holes with a 1/8" hole saw and remove the masking tape.
14. Unscrew the Bag Lite™ and place the lite housing through the hole you just drilled.
15. Screw the housing inside the bag onto the chrome bezel outside the bag.
16. Turn in inner set screws to apply very slight pressure to secure LED in bezel.
17. DO NOT over tighten! Over-tightening will damage lite, and will void the warranty on the LED.
18. Install the round aluminum wire guards on the Bag Lites™ (make sure not to pinch wires).
19. Do this to both saddlebags.
20. Drill a 29/64 in the backside lower angled corner (where the shock absorber indent is and 9/16" from the rear of the bag).
21. Install the rubber grommet (it's on the wire) and run the wire through the bag, and plug into the bag lites.
22. With the supplied adhesive wire ties, place them going up the back side of the bag and run the wire through the adhesive clips and connect the quick disconnect wire to the wire from the fender.
23. If you want to have your Bag Lites™ triple function (run, turn and brake) simply plug in a Cycle Visions electronic controller Part # CV-4805.
